GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

PARTICIPATION & GROWTH

To sustainably maintain and grow VTCA Senior Cricket Participation in North West Melbourne by 5% per year.

- ➤ Engage and work with Cricket Victoria & Cricket Australia to promote and grow the game.
- Promotion of diversity and growth of under-represented community groups eg. female participation and people from non traditional cricket backgrounds.
- Promote and expand our Under 18 concept to bolster retention of juniors progressing into Senior Cricket.

- Continue to develop streams of media communications to promote the VTCA and the sport generally eg. radio, print, social media, podcasting.
- Expansion in clubs and teams from both Northern and Western growth corridors.
- Grow and further develop a professional umpiring panel.



LOCAL GOVERNMENT & INFRASTRUCTURE

To maintain strong partnerships with local government and playing infrastructure providers to secure future operations and cater for growth.

- Assist clubs with local government interactions to improve relationships and facilities.
- Develop strategies to maximise the use of existing facilities to underpin competition growth and achieve utilisation targets.
- Work collaboratively with local government to ensure ground and facility upgrades do not severely impact clubs ability to compete, to work within specified timelines and within budgetary restraints.
